- 1. There is a \$35.00 non-refundable application fee.
- 2. Only 10 contestants per age group will be accepted. This will be on a first come first serve basis and application must be completed and fee PAID.
- Applications are available online at www.franklinsouthamptoncountyfair.org.
- Contestants must be single, never married, without children, and never have been pregnant.
- Contestant must be female who has always been female.
- Must be a Franklin/Southampton resident or attend a Franklin/Southampton County School for at least six months.
- 7. Category Guidelines as follows:
  - Wee (3-4 years) must be 3 by August 06, 2023
  - Little (5-7 years) must be 5 by August 06, 2023
  - Junior (8-10 years) must be 8 by August 06, 2023
  - Pre-teen (11-13 years) must be 11 by August 06, 2023
  - Teen (14-16 years) must be 14 by August 06, 2023
  - If turning 17 on or before August 06, 2023, you must compete in Miss Franklin/Southampton County Fair Pageant.
  - Age divisions are subject to change.
  - If you win a title, you must sit out a year before competing again, this also, includes Miss Heart. Exception to the rule is Teen Category, this age division moves up to a different pageant.
    - If you are crowned you are expected to give Franklin-Southampton County Fair 100%, with the expectations of not doing another reigning pageant or already have a reigning title. (Fun pageants are allowed.)
- 9. Application may be TYPED or HAND WRITTEN NEATLEY and submitted with a black and white 5x7 HEAD SHOT, copy of contestant's birth certificate, signature sheet and photo release form. The complete application is due on or before June 16, 2023, or early bird May 19<sup>th</sup> (\$25.00) by 5 p.m. and must be submitted to the Pageant Director.
- 10. Wee, Little, Junior and Pre-teen contestants will be judged on their personality wear and pageant dress.
  - The entered photo may not be changed once entered.
  - Wee and Little must wear white patent leather shoes with pageant dress.

- Juniors and Pre-teens must wear a FULL LENGTH pageant dress (evening gown).
- 11. All contestants should conduct themselves in a "ladylike" manner at all times. (This includes any social media posts)
  - No bullying during practice and pageant
  - Show respect at practice and pageant.
- 12. All contestants will be expected to participate in any fundraising activities, pageant kick-off and rehearsals. Absences will not be tolerated as well as non-participation.
- 13. Only the queen of each age group will be required to represent Franklin/Southampton County Fair (all 4 days of the fair) as well as in future parades and other functions. Queens are to represent the fair as a court (group) only. If a Queen is interested in participating in an activity as an individual, it must be approved by the Pageant Director.
  - Wee and Little are only required to attend the Fair on Saturday morning for kid's activities.
- 14. The 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up will only be required to fulfill the duties of the Queen, if needed to at the request of the Pageant Director.
