## 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Little Miss Scholarship Pageant

### Rules and Regulations

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#### Pageant Directors

1. There is a \$30.00 non-refundable application fee.
2. Only 10 contestants per age group will be accepted. This will be on a first come first serve basis and application must be completed and fee PAID.
3. Applications are available online at [www.franklinsouthamptoncountyfair.org](http://www.franklinsouthamptoncountyfair.org).
4. Contestant must be single, never married, without children, and never having been pregnant.
5. Contestant must be female who has always been female.
6. Must be a Franklin/Southampton resident, attend a Franklin/Southampton County School for at least six months or live within 30 miles of the fairgrounds.
7. Category Guidelines as follows:
  - Wee (3-4 years) must be 3 by August 10, 2022
  - Little (5-7 years) must be 5 by August 10, 2022
  - Junior (8-10 years) must be 8 by August 10, 2022
  - Pre-teen (11-13 years) must be 11 by August 10, 2022
8. If you win your age division, you must sit out a year before competing again.
  - If you are crowned you are expected to give Franklin-Southampton County Fair 100%, with the expectations of not doing another reigning pageant or already have a reigning title.
9. Application may be **TYPED** or **HANDWRITTEN** NEATLY and submitted with a black and white 5x7 **HEAD SHOT**, copy of contestant's birth certificate, signature sheet and photo release form. The complete application is due on or before June 14, 2022, by 5 p.m. and must be submitted to the Pageant Director.
10. Wee, Little, Junior and Pre-teen contestants will be judged on their, personality wear and pageant dress.
  - The entered photo may not be changed once entered.
  - Wee and Little must wear white patent leather shoes with pageant dress.
  - Juniors and Pre-teens must wear a FULL-LENGTH pageant dress (evening gown).
11. All contestants should conduct themselves in a "ladylike" manner at all times. (This includes any social media posts)
12. All contestants will be expected to participate in the fundraising activity and are required to attend all meetings and rehearsals. Absences will not be tolerated as well as non-participation.
13. Contestants can miss ONE meeting or practice, without a deduction, all other absences will result in a 1-point deduction per judge.
14. All Contestants must sign in at each practice.

15. Only the queen of each age group will be required to represent Franklin/Southampton County Fair on Saturday August 13(may come every day of the fair in crown and sash if you wish) as well as in future parades and other functions. Queens are to represent the fair as a court (group) only. If a Queen is interested in participating in an activity as an individual, it must be approved by the Pageant Director.
